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## The WGO Train the Trainers Program

Developed by WGO in 2001, this workshop concentrates on expanding the educational skills of educators in the fields of gastroenterology, hepatology, endoscopy, and GI surgery, who are responsible for teaching, through the use of current educational techniques and philosophies.

A maximum number of 50 participants (25 from local host country and 25 additional, with two max from other country/member societies) are accepted for each course. This enables an intimate group of participants and faculty from across the globe to engage in an intensive and interactive workshop, characterized by numerous hands-on sessions with ample opportunity for discussion.

Since 2001, WGO has held over 25 TTT Workshops in 18 different countries with over 1000 participants from more than 90 countries.

Participants are also required to engage actively in all sessions and social functions; hence they are required to attend the workshop each day.

Emmanuelle Williams is an Associate Professor in the Department of Gastroenterology at Penn State Hershey and the Associate Medical Director of the Penn State Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) Center. Her practice is dedicated solely to the care of patients with IBD. She runs combined colorectal surgery-gastroenterology IBD clinics as well as combined pediatric IBD-Adult IBD transition clinics at Penn State Hershey. The Center has managed the care of over 5500 IBD patients to date. Her research interests include Pouchitis and transition of care of IBD patients. Dr. Williams is the Director of Problem Based Learning for the Penn State College of Medicine, Director of Integrative Pre-Clinical Curriculum Development, and Course Director of the Medical Student pre-clinical and clinical Gastroenterology Courses.

Dr. Williams grew up in Belgium and is bilingual in French and English. She is a graduate of Yale University and Jefferson Medical School. She completed her internal medicine residency at the University of Michigan, and her Gastroenterology fellowship at the University of Florida.

Dr. Williams, her husband, an Ophthalmologist, and two young daughters reside in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania



### **Cihan Yurdaydin, MD**

Professor Cihan Yurdaydin specialized in Internal Medicine at the University of Ankara Medical School, Turkey, after gaining his medical degree from the same establishment. After a year of national service at Gümüssuyu Military Hospital and two years at Van State Hospital, he returned to the University of Ankara Medical School to specialize in gastroenterology. Dr. Yurdaydin has worked for one year on hepatic encephalopathy at the University of Vienna, Austria and was a visiting fellow at the Liver Diseases Section of the National Institutes of Health between 1991 and 1993. Professor Yurdaydin currently is a Professor of Gastroenterology at Koc University.

Professor Yurdaydin was an Editorial Board member of the *Journal of Hepatology* from 1995 to 2000 and has been Editor-in-Chief of *The Turkish Journal of Gastroenterology* from 1999 to 2013. He was an associate editor for *Liver International* from 2007 to 2012. Prof. Yurdaydin has published in peer reviewed journals such as the *NEJM*, *Nature Reviews*, *Gastroenterology*, *Hepatology* and *Journal of Hepatology*. He co-organized 2 EASL Monothematic Conferences in Istanbul, one on hepatitis B and the other on hepatitis Delta. An active member of the AASLD, EASL and Turkish Society for Gastroenterology, Professor Yurdaydin is also a member of the Turkish Association for the Study of the Liver and the Turkish Transplantation Society. He was an Executive Member of ASNEMGE and has served in the Scientific Committee of EASL. Prof. Yurdaydin was Educational Councilor to EASL from 2013 to 2015 and is currently serving as president for the World Gastroenterology Organisation.
