Mihai Eminescu



Mihai Eminescu was born in Botoșani on January 15, 1850. He was the seventh of the 11 children of the tavern keeper Gheorghe Eminovici. He spent his childhood in Botoșani and Ipotesti, in his parental home and its surroundings, enjoying complete freedom of movement and contact with people and nature, a state later evoked with deep nostalgia in his poetry. Between 1858 and 1866, he attended school in Cernăuți intermittently. He completed the fourth grade, ranking fifth out of 82 students, after which he attended two years of

gymnasium.

1866 marked the year of Eminescu's first literary manifestations. In January, his Romanian language teacher, Aron Pumnul, passed away, and the students published a brochure that included the poem "La mormântul lui Aron Pumnul" signed by M. Eminoviciu.

From 1866 to 1869, he wandered along the routes of Cernăuți - Blaj - Sibiu and Giurgiu - Bucharest. In fact, these were years of getting to know the Romanian people, language, customs, and realities through direct contact. At Pascaly's recommendation, he moved to the National Theater as a prompter and copier, where he met I. L. Caragiale. He continued to publish in "Familia," wrote poems, dramas (such as "Mira"), fragments of a novel ("Geniu pustiu" - "Empty Genius") and translated from German.

Between 1869 and 1872, he pursued his studies as a student in Vienna. He attended as an "extraordinary auditor" at the Faculty of Philosophy and Law. He befriended Ioan Slavici, met Veronica Micle in Vienna, and began collaborating with "Convorbiri literare" magazine.

From 1872 to 1874, he studied in Berlin, and "Junimea" granted him a scholarship on the condition that he obtain a doctorate in philosophy. He attended two semesters regularly but did not sit for the exams. He returned to Romania, living in Iași between 1874 and 1877, working as the director of the Central Library, substitute teacher, school inspector for the counties of Iași and Vaslui, and editor at the newspaper "Curierul de Iași" (The Iași Courier).

In June 1883, exhausted, the poet fell seriously ill and was admitted to Dr. Sutu's hospital, and later to an institute near Vienna. In December, his volume "Poezii" (Poems) was published, with texts selected by Titu Maiorescu (it was the only volume published during Eminescu's lifetime).

Mihai Eminescu passed away on June 15, 1889, around 4 o'clock, at Dr. Sutu's sanatorium. He was buried in Bellu Cemetery in Bucharest.

Ion Creangă



He was born on 1 March 1837 in Humulești. His parents were Ștefan a Petrei Ciubotarul and Smaranda Creangă. He had seven other siblings.

In 1847 he started school near the church of his native village, Humulești, where the children were taught by the village teacher. Later he is sent to grandfather on his mother's side, David Creanga. He takes him to the school in Broșteni. In 1853 he is enrolled at the Școala Domnească in Târgu Neamț, under the name of Ștefănescu Ion. There, he had Father Isaia Teodorescu (Popa Duhu) as his teacher. Smaranda, a very ambitious woman, wanted

her son to become a priest and therefore enrolled him at the Chastic School in Fălticeni. At this school he appeared under the name Ion Creanga, a name he would keep all his life. The school in Fălticeni was closed, so Ion Creangă left for Iași and enrolled in the lower course of the theological seminary.

From 1855 to 1859, Creanga attended the seminary, and then, after obtaining his certificate, he returned to his native village, which he loved so much and never wanted to leave. He later married Ileana, the daughter of the priest Ioan Grigoriu of the church Patruzeci de sfinți in Iași, and became deacon of this church.

In 1864 Creanga met Titu Maiorescu, who appointed him teacher at the Primary School No. 1 in Iași. For 12 years he was a teacher and deacon at various churches in Iași, but because he did not respect certain rules imposed by the church he was permanently excluded from the clergy. In 1875 he met Mihai Eminescu, with whom he had a beautiful and lasting friendship. The latter, realising Creanga's talent as a storyteller, urged him to put down on paper what he had so amusingly told.

Between 1875 and 1883 he wrote his most important works. Between 1883 and 1889 he was mostly ill. He suffered a lot when Eminescu died, so that on the last day of the same year that Eminescu died (1889) the great storyteller died in his cellar at Țicău.

Alexandru Ioan Cuza, founding father of modern Romania



Alexandru Ioan Cuza was born in Bârlad in 1820. He did his first studies at a boarding school in Iași, then took his baccalaureate in Paris. He was among those who took part in the 1848 revolution in Moldavia, sharing, like his generation mates Vasile Alecsandri and Mihail Kogălniceanu, the ideal of creating a strong Romanian state.

He was president of the Covurlui court, and in 1856 he became the parish priest of Galati, a position from which he resigned in protest the falsification of the elections for the ad hoc Divan. As the great powers had decided to accept the union of Moldavia with

Romanian Country, Alexandru Ioan Cuza was elected ruler of Moldavia on 5 January 1859 and of Romanian Country on 24 January 1859, the first step towards the establishment of modern Romania. From 1859 to 1866, his reign represented further steps towards modernization by achieving full union, with only one lord, one government and one assembly, but also by carrying out important reforms, including agrarian and education reforms, and adopting a new fundamental law.

In 1866 Al. I. Cuza is forced to abdicate, the Romanian state is now ready for a new phase, that of a foreign prince to continue his modernizing work.

He went into exile in Vienna, then to Paris, Florence and Heidelberg in Germany. He would die at the age of 53. He was initially buried in the royal church near the Palace of Ruginoasa, according to his wishes, and later his body was brought to the Church of the Three Hierarchs in Iasi.

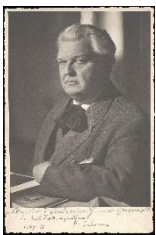

Mihail Sadoveanu



Mihail Sadoveanu (born November 5, 1880, Pașcani, Romania – died October 19, 1961, Vânători-Neamț, Neamț County, Romania) was a Romanian writer, storyteller, novelist, academician, and politician. He is one of the most important and prolific Romanian prose writers of the first half of the 20th century, with a career spanning fifty years. He is best known for his historical and adventure novels, although he also created immortal pages about the peasant world of Moldova, the nature of Romania, and wrote reports and memoirs. His work can be grouped into several phases that correspond to dominant literary directions or currents in a particular era: an initial Sămănătorist stage, the beginning of his career with his early attempts, short stories, and tales, and a second mythic-symbolic stage during the interwar period (reflected in novels such as *Creanga de aur* or *Divanul persian*). In this stage, the action of his works generally takes place in the historical region of Moldova, with themes derived from the medieval and early modern history of Romania, in novels such as *Neamul Șoimăreștilor*, *Frații Jderi*, and *Zodia Cancerului*. Through works like *Venea o moară pe Siret...*, *Baltagul*, and other writings, Sadoveanu covers a wider span of time, including contemporary history, and explores other styles such as psychological novels and naturalism. The last stage corresponds to socialist realism, in line with the socialist-communist period to which Sadoveanu ideologically adhered. As a politician, he was an advocate of nationalism and humanism, with Sadoveanu oscillating between right-wing and left-wing political forces during the interwar period. He was initially a member of the People's Party, the National Liberal Party-Brătianu, and Constantin Argetoianu's Agrarian Party, serving as the President of the Senate.

During this period, he was appointed President of the Chamber of Deputies and was one of the five members of the provisional Presidium of the Romanian People's Republic, which assumed leadership of the state after the king's abdication. He wrote in favor of the Soviet Union and Stalinism. Many of his works and speeches, including the political novel *Mitrea Cocor* and the famous slogan "Lumina vine de la Răsărit" (The Light Comes from the East), are also considered propaganda in favor of communism. He was the President of the Romanian Writers' Union and, starting from 1921, a member of the Romanian Academy. He received the Lenin Peace Prize in 1961. In 1928, he became the Grand Master of the National Grand Lodge of Romania. He was the brother-in-law of literary critic Izabela Sadoveanu-Evan. His children, Profira and Paul-Mihu Sadoveanu, followed in their father's footsteps and also became writers.

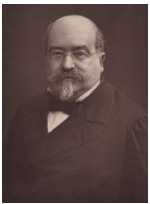

Mihail Kogalniceanu



He was born in Iasi, in the family of the Moldavian nobleman Kogalniceanu, being the son of Vornic Ilie Kogalniceanu and great-grandson of Constantin Kogalniceanu (known for having signed in 1749 the document that abolished serfdom in Moldavia, issued by Prince Constantin Mavrocordat). Mihail's mother, Catinca was, according to Kogalniceanu, "from a Romanian family in Bessarabia".

Mihail Kogalniceanu was educated at the Trei Ierarhi Monastery in Iași, before being trained by Gherman Vida, a monk who belonged to the Ardelene School and was associated with Gheorghe Șincai. He finished primary school in Miroslava, where he taught at Cuénim's boarding school. It was during this period that he first met the poet Vasile Alecsandri, Costache Negri and Alexandru Ioan Cuza.

Mihail Kogalniceanu, politician, historian, writer, journalist, diplomat, founding member of the Romanian Academic Society and president of the Romanian Academy. A close collaborator of the ruler Alexandru Ioan Cuza, the two statesmen drew up together an extensive plan of reforms that would lay the foundations for the establishment of the modern Romanian state. President of the Council of Ministers, holder of the Ministry of the Interior and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Kogalniceanu was one of the most important statesmen of his generation.

It was during his tenure at the head of the Foreign Ministry that Romania gained its independence as a state. A personality with extensive political and diplomatic experience, he was one of the outstanding leaders of the National Liberal Party. At the same time, Mihail Kogalniceanu was one of the greatest men of culture of the 19th century, successfully contributing to the research of national history and the development of Romanian literature. He founded the magazine "Dacia literară" and in his inaugural article he summarized the ideals of the Pasoptist writers, thus laying the foundations of the Pasoptist movement in literature. In recognition of his contribution to the development of culture, he was elected president of the Romanian Academy.

Mihail Kogalniceanu died on an operating table in Paris on 20 June 1891, aged 74. He is buried at the Eternitatea Cemetery in Iași.

MAVIRET este indicat pentru tratamentul hepatitei cronice cu virus C la adulți și la adolescenți cu vârsta de 12 ani și peste. Pentru informații complete de prescriere, vă rugăm să consultați Rezumatul Caracteristicilor Produsului.

Maviret 100 mg/40 mg comprimate filmate – Informații esențiale din Rezumatul Caracteristicilor Produsului

Compoziția cantitativă și calitativă: Fiecare comprimat filmat conține glecaprevir 100 mg și pibrentasvir 40 mg. Excipient cu efect cunoscut: Fiecare comprimat filmat conține lactoză 7,48 mg (sub formă de monohidrat). **Indicații terapeutice:** Maviret este indicat pentru tratamentul infecției cronice cu virusul hepatitic C (VHC) la adulți și la copii cu vârsta de 3 ani și peste. **Doze și mod de administrare:** Iratamentul cu Maviret trebuie inițiat și monitorizat de către un medic cu experiență în tratamentul pacienților cu infecție cu virusul hepatitic C (VHC). *La adulți, adolescenți cu vârsta de 12 ani și peste, sau copii cu greutatea de cel puțin 45 kg,* doza recomandată este de 300 mg/120 mg (trei comprimate a câte 100 mg/40 mg), administrată pe cale orală, o dată pe zi, în timpul mesei. Durata recomandată a tratamentului cu Maviret pentru pacienții infectați cu VHC, genotipul 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 sau 6 și cu boală hepatică compensată (cu sau fără ciroză), netratați anterior pentru VHC, este de 8 săptămâni. Durata recomandată a tratamentului cu Maviret pentru pacienții care au avut eșec la tratamentul anterior cu peg-IFN + ribavirină +/- sofosbuvir sau sofosbuvir + ribavirină, care au infecție cu genotipul 1, 2, 4-6 și care nu au ciroză este de 8 săptămâni, iar pentru cei cu ciroză compensată este de 12 săptămâni. Durata recomandată a tratamentului cu Maviret pentru pacienții care au avut eșec la tratamentul anterior cu peg-IFN + ribavirină +/- sofosbuvir sau sofosbuvir + ribavirină, care au infecție cu genotipul 3, cu sau fără ciroză compensată, este de 16 săptămâni. Omiterea dozei: În cazul omiterii unei doze de Maviret, doza prescrisă trebuie luată în interval de 18 ore de la momentul în care trebuia administrată. Dacă au trecut mai mult de 18 ore de la momentul în care Maviret este administrat de obicei, doza omisă nu mai trebuie luată, iar pacientul trebuie să ia următoarea doză conform schemei uzuale de administrare. Pacienții trebuie instruiți să nu ia o doză dublă. În cazul în care apar vărsături în interval de 3 ore de la administrare, trebuie luată o doză suplimentară de Maviret. Dacă vărsăturile apar după mai mult de 3 ore de la administrare, nu este necesară administrarea unei doze suplimentare de Maviret. Insuficiență hepatică: Nu este necesară ajustarea dozei de Maviret la pacienții cu insuficiență hepatică ușoară (Child-Pugh A). Maviret nu este recomandat la pacienții cu insuficiență hepatică moderată (Child-Pugh B) și este contraindicat la pacienții cu insuficiență hepatică severă (Child-Pugh C). Pacienți cu transplant hepatic sau renal: A fost evaluat un tratament cu durata de 12 săptămâni și acesta se recomandă la pacienții cu sau fără ciroză, cu transplant hepatic sau renal. Trebuie luată în considerare o durată a tratamentului de 16 săptămâni la pacienții infectați cu genotipul 3 și care au fost tratați anterior cu peg-IFN + ribavirină +/- sofosbuvir sau sofosbuvir + ribavirină. Pacienți cu infecție concomitentă HIV-1: Pentru recomandări privind doza atunci când se utilizează concomitent medicamente antivirale, a se vedea pct. 4.5 din RCP complet. Copii și adolescenți: Siguranța și eficacitatea Maviret la copii cu vârsta sub 3 ani sau cu greutatea sub 12 kg nu au fost încă stabilite și nu sunt disponibile date. Maviret sub formă de granule drajefiate este indicat pentru administrare la copii cu vârsta cuprinsă între 3 ani și mai puțin de 12 ani, cântărind între 12 kg și mai puțin de 45 kg. Deoarece formele farmaceutice au profiluri farmacocinetice diferite, comprimatele și granulele drajefiate nu sunt interschimbabile. Prin urmare, este necesar un tratament complet cu aceeași formă farmaceutică. Pacienții trebuie instruiți să înghită comprimatele întregi cu alimente și să nu mestece, să nu zdrobească sau să nu rupă comprimatele, deoarece biodisponibilitatea medicamentului se poate modifica. **Contraindicații:** Hipersensibilitate la substanțele active sau la oricare dintre excipienți. Pacienți cu insuficiență hepatică severă (Child-Pugh C). Administrare concomitentă cu medicamente care conțin atazanavir, atorvastatină, simvastatină, dabigatran etexilat, medicamente ce conțin etinilestradiol, inductori puternici ai CYP3A și gp-P (de exemplu rifampicină, carbamazepină, sunătoare (*Hypericum perforatum*), fenobarbital, fenitoină și primidonă). **Atenționări și precauții speciale pentru utilizare:** Reactivarea virusului hepatitic B: În timpul sau după tratamentul cu medicamente antivirale cu acțiune directă, au fost raportate cazuri de reactivare a virusului hepatitic B (VHB), unele dintre acestea fiind letale. Înainte de începerea tratamentului trebuie să fie efectuat la toți pacienții screening-ul pentru VHB. Pacienții cu infecție concomitentă cu VHC/VHB prezintă risc de reactivare a VHB și, în consecință, trebuie monitorizați și tratați conform ghidurilor clinice curente. Pacienții care au avut eșec la un tratament anterior care a conținut un inhibitor NS3/4A și/sau NS5A: Maviret nu este recomandat pentru repetarea tratamentului la pacienții cu expunere prealabilă la inhibitorii ai NS3/4A și/sau NS5A. Utilizarea la pacienții cu diabet: Persoanele cu diabet pot prezenta un control glicemic ameliorat, care poate duce la hipoglicemie simptomatică, după inițierea tratamentului antiviral cu acțiune directă pentru VHC. La pacienții cu diabet care încep tratamentul antiviral cu acțiune directă, valorile glucozei trebuie monitorizate cu atenție, în special în primele 3 luni, iar medicamentele pentru diabet trebuie modificate după caz. Medicul responsabil de îngrijirea pacientului cu diabet trebuie informat când se inițiază tratamentul antiviral cu acțiune directă. Pacienții cu afecțiuni ereditare rare de intoleranță la galactoză, deficit total de lactază sau sindrom de malabsorbție la glucoză-galactoză nu trebuie să utilizeze acest medicament. **Interacțiuni cu alte medicamente:** Glecaprevir și pibrentasvir sunt inhibitori ai glicoproteinei P (gp-P), ai proteinei de rezistență în cancerul mamar (*breast cancer resistance protein*, BCRP) și ai polipeptidului transportor de anioni organici (OATP) 1B1/3. Administrarea concomitentă cu Maviret poate crește concentrațiile plasmatice ale medicamentelor care sunt substraturi ale gp-P (de exemplu dabigatran etexilat, digoxină), BCRP (de exemplu rosuvastatină) sau OATP1B1/3 (de exemplu atorvastatină, lovastatină, pravastatină, rosuvastatină, simvastatină). Pentru recomandări specifice privind interacțiunile cu substraturile sensibile ale gp-P, BCRP și OATP1B1/3, vezi **tabelul 3** din RCP complet. Pentru alte substraturi ale gp-P, BCRP sau OATP1B1/3, poate fi necesară ajustarea dozei. *In vivo*, glecaprevir și pibrentasvir sunt inhibitori slabi ai citocromului P450 (CYP) 3A și ai uridin glucuronozil-transferazei (UGT) 1A1. *In vitro*, atât glecaprevir, cât și pibrentasvir inhibă pompa de export a sărurilor biliare (*bile salt export pump*, BSEP). Pacienți tratați cu antagoniști ai vitaminei K: Deoarece funcția hepatică se poate modifica în timpul tratamentului cu Maviret, se recomandă monitorizarea atentă a valorilor raportului internațional normalizat (INR). Utilizarea cu inductori puternici ai gp-P/CYP3A: vezi Contraindicații. Administrarea concomitentă a Maviret cu medicamente care sunt inductori moderati ai gp-P/CYP3A poate să scadă concentrațiile plasmatice ale glecaprevir și pibrentasvir (de exemplu oxcarbazepină, eslicarbazepină, lumacaftor, crizotinib). Nu se recomandă administrarea concomitentă de inductori moderati ai Maviret. Administrarea concomitentă a Maviret cu medicamente care inhibă gp-P și BCRP (de exemplu ciclosporină, cobicistat, dronedaronă, itraconazol, ketoconazol, ritonavir) pot să încetinească eliminarea glecaprevirului și pibrentasvirului, crescând astfel expunerea plasmatică la antivirale. Medicamentele care inhibă OATP1B1/3 (de exemplu eltegravir, ciclosporină, darunavir, lopinavir) cresc concentrațiile plasmatice ale glecaprevir. **Tabelul 3** din RCP complet prezintă efectul raportului mediilor celor mai mici pătrate (interval de încredere 90%) pentru concentrația plasmatică a Maviret și a unor medicamente uzuale administrate concomitent. **Sarcina:** Nu se cunosc sau sunt date limitate provenite din utilizarea glecaprevir sau pibrentasvir la femeile gravide (mai puțin de 300 rezultate obținute în timpul sarcinilor). Ca măsură de precauție, utilizarea Maviret nu este recomandată în timpul sarcinii. **Alăptarea:** Nu se poate exclude un risc pentru copilul alăptat. Trebuie luată decizia fie de a întrerupe alăptarea, fie de a întrerupe/de a nu începe tratamentul cu Maviret, având în vedere beneficiul alăptării pentru copil și beneficiul tratamentului pentru mamă. **Reacții adverse:** În fazele 2 și 3 grupate ale studiilor clinice cu subiecți adulți, cărora li se administrează tratament cu Maviret pentru infecțiile cu VHC genotip 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 sau 6, reacțiile adverse cel mai frecvent raportate (incidență $\geq 10\%$) au fost cefaleea și fatigabilitatea. Mai puțin de 0,1% dintre subiecții tratați cu Maviret au avut reacții adverse grave (accident vascular cerebral ischemic tranzitor). Procentul subiecților tratați cu Maviret care au oprit definitiv tratamentul din cauza reacțiilor adverse a fost de 0,1%. Următoarele reacții adverse au fost identificate în studiile de fază 2 și 3 pentru autorizare la pacienții adulți infectați cu VHC, cu sau fără ciroză, cărora li s-a administrat Maviret timp de 8, 12 sau 16 săptămâni sau în timpul experienței de după punerea pe piață: Foarte frecvente ($\geq 1/10$): cefalee, fatigabilitate; Frecvente ($\geq 1/100$ și $< 1/10$): diaree, greață, astenie, creștere a valorilor bilirubinei totale; Mai puțin frecvente ($\geq 1/1000$ și $< 1/100$): angioedem; Cu frecvență necunoscută (nu poate fi estimată din datele disponibile): prurit. **Reacții adverse la subiecții cu insuficiență renală severă, incluzând subiecții care efectuează sedinte de dializă:** Cele mai frecvente reacții adverse la subiecții cu insuficiență renală severă au fost pruritul (17%) și fatigabilitatea (12%) în EXPEDITION-4 și pruritul (14,9%) în EXPEDITION-5. Copii și adolescenți. Siguranța utilizării Maviret la adolescenții infectați cu VHC GT1-6 se bazează pe datele dintr-un studiu deschis de fază 2/3 (DORA-Partea 1) cu 47 subiecți cu vârsta de 12 ani până la <18 ani tratați cu Maviret timp de 8 până la 16 săptămâni. Reacțiile adverse observate au fost comparabile cu cele observate în studiile clinice cu Maviret efectuate la adulți. **Raportarea reacțiilor adverse suspectate:** Profesioniștii din domeniul sănătății sunt rugați să raporteze orice reacție adversă suspectată la: Agenția Națională a Medicamentului și a Dispozitivelor Medicale din România, Str. Trebuie să se instituie imediat tratament simptomatic adecvat.
